### **PUBLIC HEARING**

**ORDINANCE No. 16 for 2025** - An Ordinance to amend §260-46 of the Code of the City of Watervliet.

**RESOLUTION No. 80 for 2025** – A Resolution approving a contract agreement for Consulting and Management Services between the City of Watervliet and MFCS, LLC for a period of three (3) years commencing on January 1, 2026, and ending on December 31, 2029, and further authorizing and directing Mayor Charles V. Patricelli to execute same.

*Councilwoman Diamond made a motion to move on this resolution which was seconded by Councilman Daus. The Resolution passed 3-0.*

**RESOLUTION No. 81 for 2025** – A Resolution approving a chemical service agreement for Poly Aluminum Chloride and authorizing Mayor Charles V. Patricelli to execute same.

*Councilman Daus made a motion to move on this resolution which was seconded by Councilwoman Diamond. The Resolution passed 3-0.*

**RESOLUTION No. 82 for 2025** – A Resolution approving a chemical service agreement for Zinc Phosphate Inhibitor and authorizing Mayor Charles V. Patricelli to execute same.

*Councilwoman Diamond made a motion to move on this resolution which was seconded by Councilman Daus. The Resolution passed 3-0.*

**RESOLUTION No. 83 for 2025** – A Resolution establishing a 25h Street Redevelopment Project Capital Account/Reserve Fund.

*Councilman Daus made a motion to move on this resolution which was seconded by Councilwoman Diamond. The Resolution passed 3-0.*
