RESOLUTION No. 21 for 2026 – A Bond Resolution dated March 5, 2026 of the Council of the City of Watervliet authorizing not to exceed \$9,400,000 aggregate principal amount of Serial General Obligation bonds to finance the demolition of the existing pool and bathhouse and construction of a new swimming pool facility at an estimated cost of (\$9,400,000) said amount to be offset by any grants received. The expenditure of such sum for such purposes, the levy of tax in annual installments in payment thereof and determining other matters in connection therewith.

RESOLUTION No. 22 for 2026 – A Resolution approving an agreement for animal sheltering services between the City of Watervliet and Boght Veterinary Clinic and directing Mayor Charles V. Patricelli to execute same.
