PUBLIC HEARING – A public hearing for the purpose of public input and comments on the proposed Local Law No. 2 for 2026 which is a Local Law regarding a zoning change for property located at 329 and 330 Broadway.

ORDINANCE No. 6 for 2026 – An Ordinance amending Section 260-42, Schedule VI of the Code of the City of Watervliet.

ORDINANCE No. 7 for 2026 – An Ordinance amending Section 260-43, Schedule VII of the Code of the City of Watervliet.

RESOLUTION 27 of 2026 – A Resolution committing local match for NY PLAYS GRANT application.

RESOLUTION 28 of 2026 – A Resolution authorizing a budget amendment to accommodate the NYS Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (NYSDHSES) grant funded purchase of a metal structure to be installed for storage in the Watervliet Police Department evidence van.

RESOLUTION 29 of 2026 - A Resolution categorizing the proposed NY PLAYS grant funded Clinton Park Expansion Project as an Unlisted Action for State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) purposes and making a determination on the environmental impacts of the proposed project.
